The reaction by state and federal agencies to the presence of wild predators is usually to kill them, often in unspeakably cruel ways. Brooks Fahy's beautifully produced films underscore the plight of wolves and other predators, and the need for a revised paradigm of predator management.

A panel discussion following the films will feature Brooks, who is also the director of Predator Defense; Jon Way, Ph.D., an expert on eastern coyotes/coywolves and the author of *Suburban Howls* and *My Yellowstone Experience*; and moderator Louise Kane, JD, a former Sea Grant fellow and predator advocate. Together, Jon and Louise drafted the **Carnivore Conservation Act**. The panel will discuss the implications for change on a local and national level.
